WELCOMING CITY POLICY

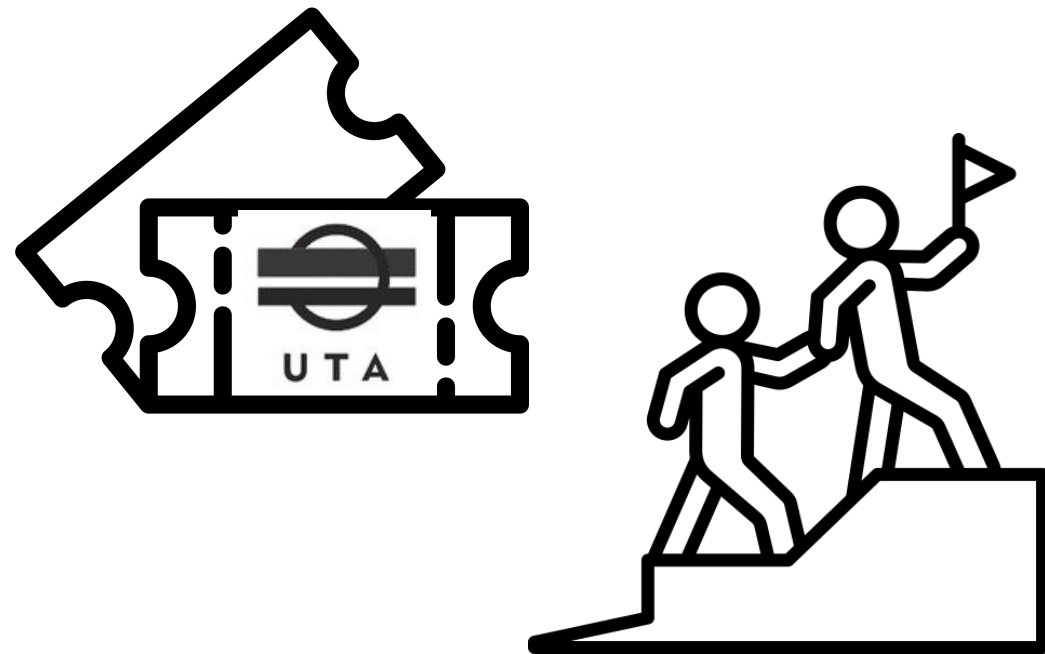


The city does not have current capabilities, and does not view this as a priority.

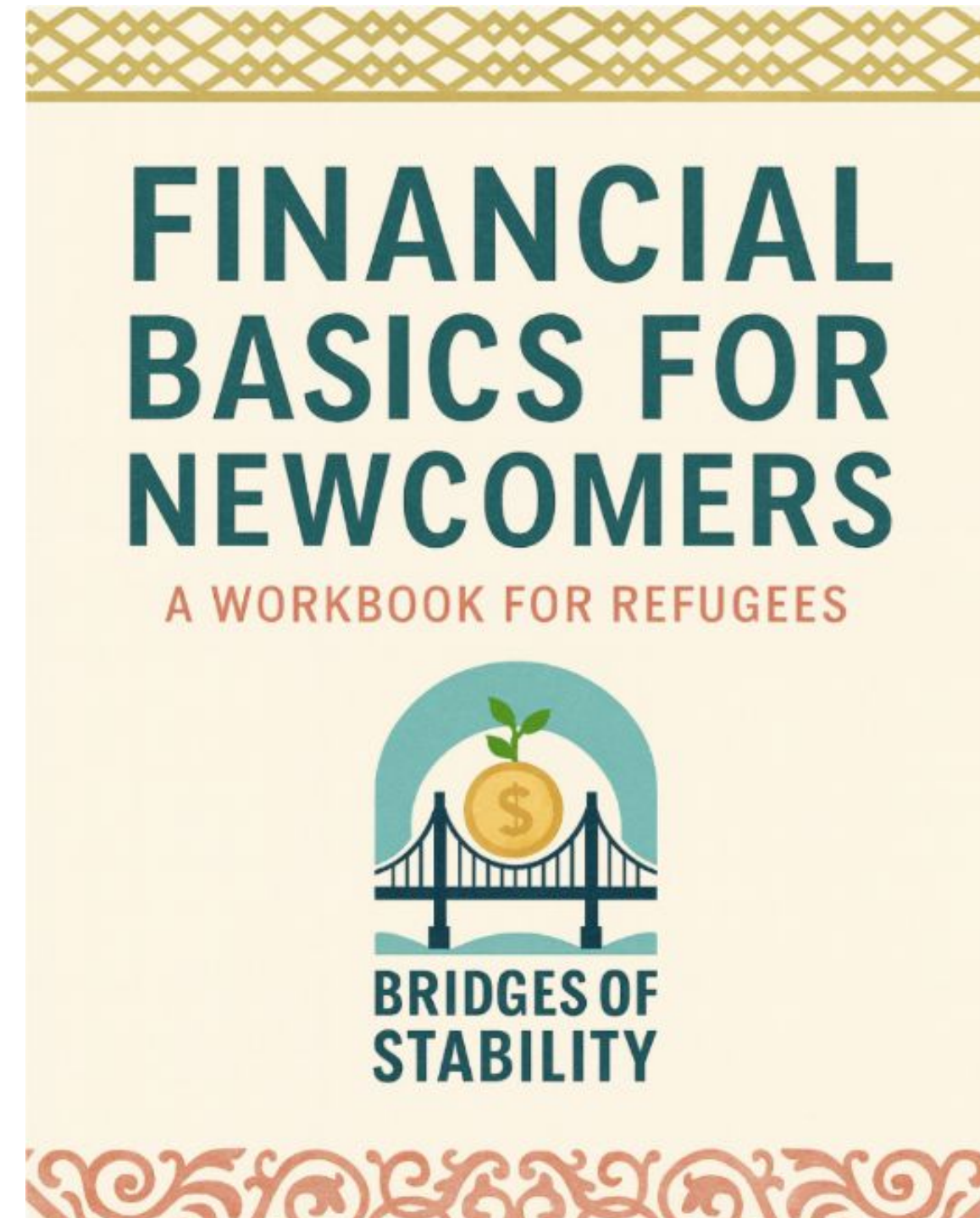
 **Let's Practice!**

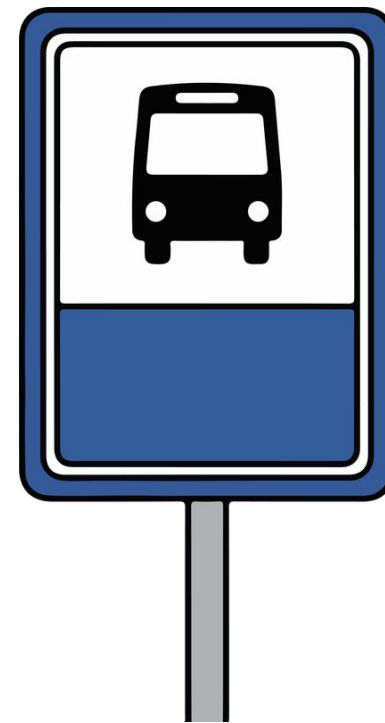
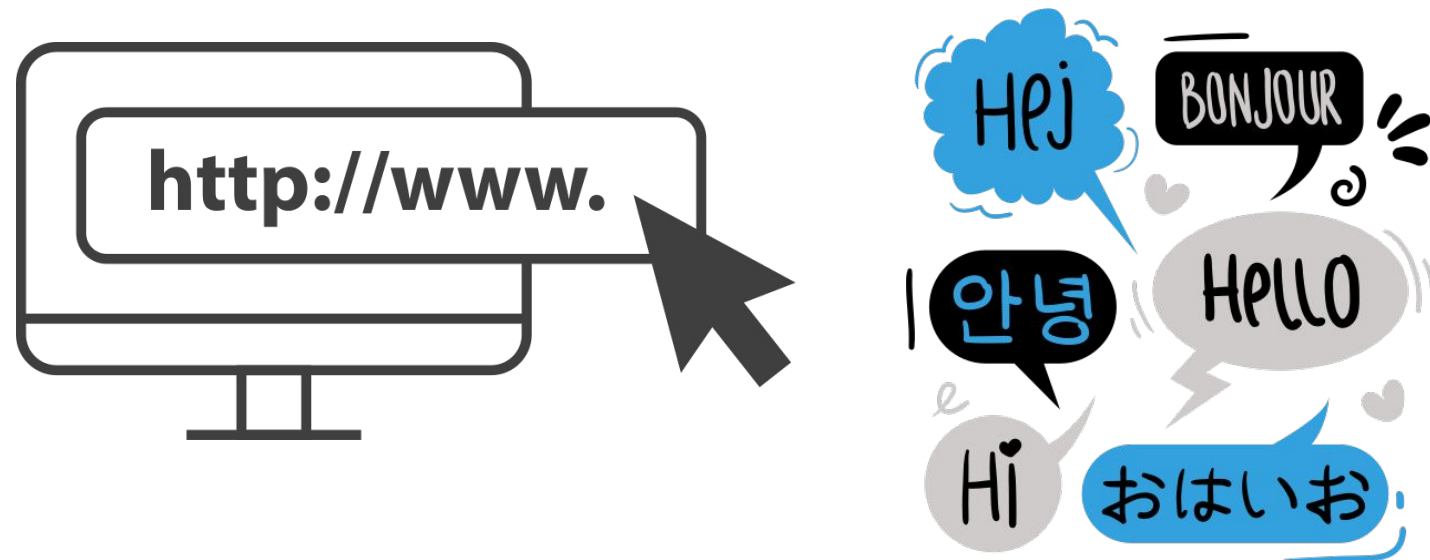
Here is a potential format you could use to organize her budget:
